## EndNote Web: Shibboleth access

One of the many irritating features of EndNote Web has been the difficulty, when logging into the service, of establishing that you are a University of Portsmouth user.

It should be easy, even automatic, but it isn't. Or wasn't. Thankfully the current version of EndNote Web has been upgraded to permit logging into the site via Shibboleth. Logging in via Shibboleth won't take you directly to your EndNote Web account but it does get you into the EndNote Web site with a clearly-established identity.

Once on the site you can either create a new account or login a pre-existing account. Logging in via Shibboleth should ensure that when you are using EndNote Web you see the customisation (mainly of Output Styles) that we've made for University of Portsmouth users.

## Major Hazards and Accidents

We have just added a new database—now making 20 databases—in **OSH Update**. It is:

Major Hazards, Accidents and Incidents Database (MHAID).

The MHAID database contains information on worldwide major hazards accidents or incidents involving hazardous materials that resulted in, or had the potential to lead to a significant impact on the public at large, including evacuation. The information covers all industries and transport.

MHAID can be used for validating assumptions and judgments in safety assessment. The contents also act as case studies and lessons learned.

The data in MHAID has been collected from regular international sources, with the emphasis where possible, in making links to the full text of the document or report of the accidents or incidents.

The data goes back many years so MHAID is a useful tool for those researching past accidents and incidents.

## Tracking the progress of your book orders

You can follow the progress of any book orders that you have sent in as follows:

Once a book has been ordered it appears in the Library Catalogue with the legend 'On Order' in place of the shelfmark.

Once a book has arrived the legend changes to 'in Cataloguing' reflecting the fact that it's in our Technical Services section being catalogued and made ready for the shelves.

Once it's out on the shelves the book's shelfmark, e.g. 331.2/LAR appears on the entry in the Library Catalogue, and the book is then available to be borrowed.
