

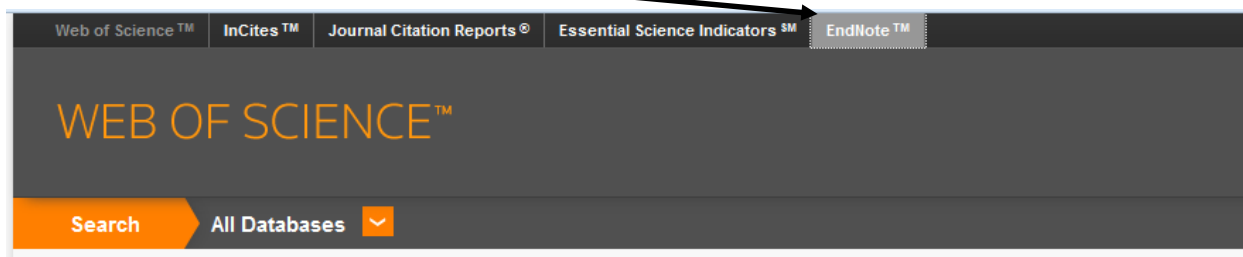
EndNote Online – how to register

EndNote Online offers two services:

Basic free service – anyone may register for a free basic EndNote Online account with 2GB of storage, and up to 21 bibliographic styles – simply register online at <http://www.myendnoteweb.com/>

Enhanced UoP access - University of Portsmouth members may register via Web of Science and benefit from a wider range of referencing styles including a UoP version of Vancouver superscript. Go to Web of Science (Library catalogue link: <http://capitadiscovery.co.uk/port/items/858307>) and select the correct on/off campus link.

From the opening page click on the EndNote tab at the very top of the screen and register:



You will be asked to verify your email address. Locate the email in your inbox to find a code which you will be asked to enter on the registration page. Complete the registration page. Be prepared to use a password that needs both upper and lower case letters, numbers and a symbol.

To start using the resource click on the EndNote tab again. You will be asked to complete one further step towards registration by agreeing to accept the End User License.

Checking your account

Log in here <http://www.myendnoteweb.com> to open your account. To check you have been recognized as a Web of Science user click on Options then Account Information.



In future, you can use either route to access your Endnote Basic Library.
