Portsmouth Municipal College superseded the Portsmouth Municipal Technical Institute.

The Municipal College opened in 1908 in what is now the University of Portsmouth's Park Building. The college expanded into premises in Anglesea Road in 1952 and became the Portsmouth College of Technology in 1953.
